Awards

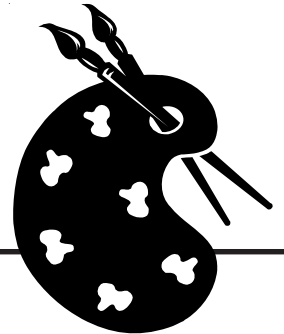
- ♦ One selection from each category will be chosen for reproduction on APPR 2007 promotional items.

- ♦ Fifteen entries from each category will be chosen for inclusion in exhibits at Library facilities.
- ♦ Certificates will be awarded to the 30 artists chosen for exhibition.

Contest winners and artists chosen for the exhibit will receive a notification letter or phone call in advance of the pick up date. Entries selected for exhibition will be retained. Pick up of exhibited entries will be Thursday, Nov. 1 from 3 - 6 p.m. in the East Library community meeting room.

Artists ages 12 and older are invited to contribute original art for a juried art competition and exhibition based on the All Pikes Peak Reads 2007 book selection:

Isabel Allende's *Zorro* will be used for adult programming.

The Mark of Zorro by Johnston McCulley will be used for school curriculum development and children's programming.

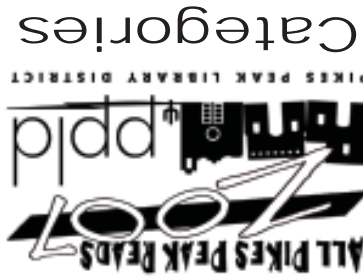
