

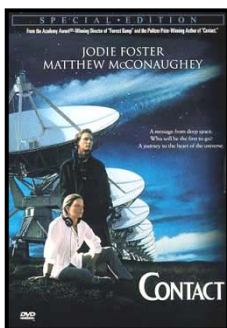

Wednesday, December 16

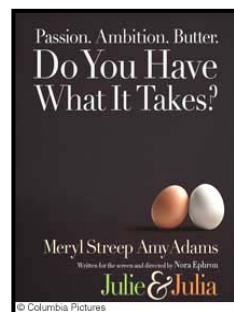
