## Paws to Read

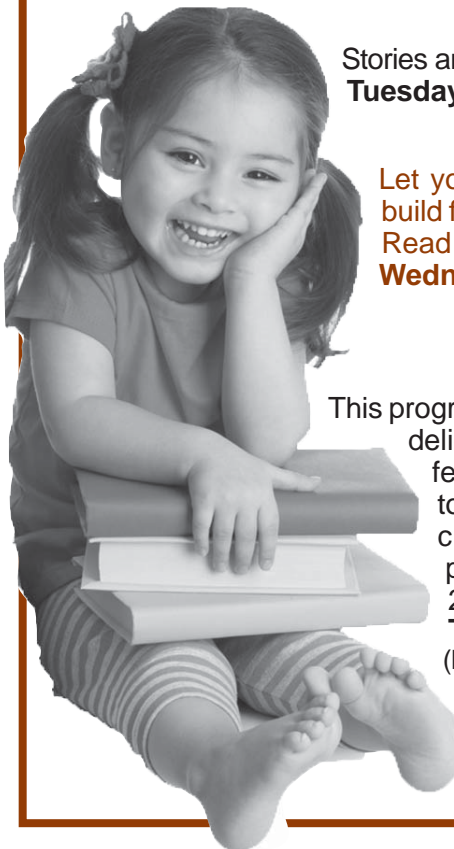
Let your child practice reading and build fluency by reading to a Paws to Read dog. No registration required.
