Carl, Joanna

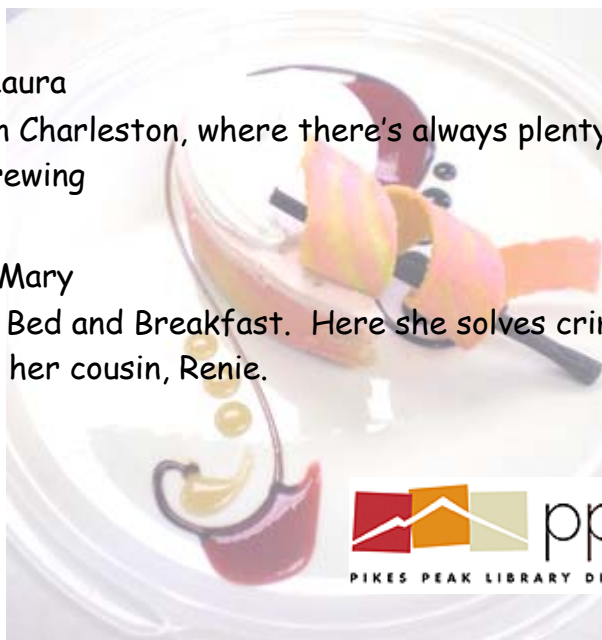
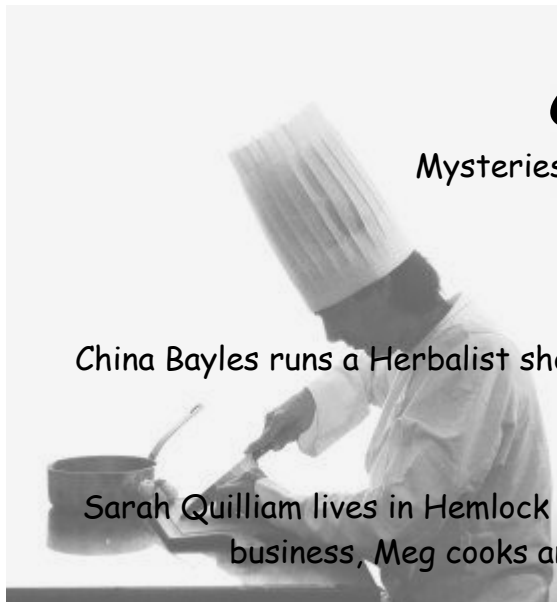

Hemlin, Tom

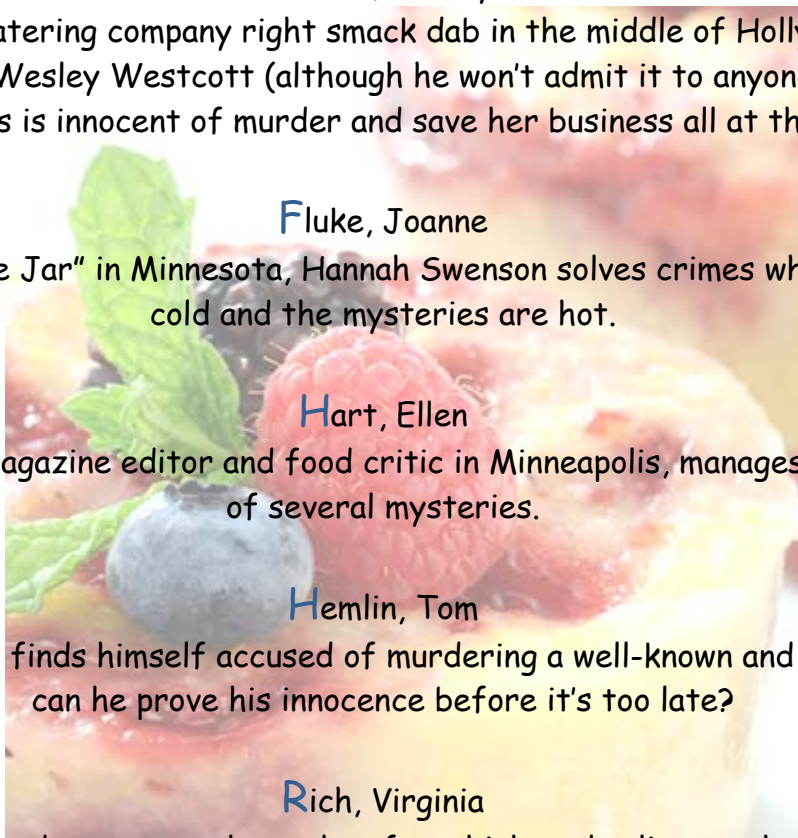
Caterer Perry Stevens finds himself accused of murdering a well-known and loved TV chef. How can he prove his innocence before it's too late?
