





Use the PressReader app:

1. Go to the app store for your device (Apple's App Store, Google's Play Store or the Microsoft Store for Windows 10) to install the free PressReader app
2. Click the **Sign In** option and then click on **Libraries & Groups**



3. In the library search box, type **Pikes** and the Pikes Peak Library District will be the only library in the search results. **Click on Pikes Peak Library District** – do not click below on the link to find a hotspot.



4. Enter your library card number and PIN

5. After you sign in with your library card number and PIN, you will see an option to create a free PressReader account. This will give you access to features such as bookmarking and sharing articles, and in the PressReader app, reading offline and having new issues of favorite titles automatically downloaded to your device. **This is optional and not needed to simply view and read titles.**

If you decide later to create the free PressReader account, log on with your library card and PIN as described in steps 2-4, and then select “Sign in” and choose “Email” as the method to create the PressReader account.

Please note: The name you enter will be publicly displayed if you subscribe to channels. You may wish to use initials or a nickname. PressReader is a third-party service that is governed by its own privacy policy and practices, not the Library's. - Use the search box to enter a title or use the Categories, Countries, Languages buttons to browse titles. Click the **More** menu in the lower right to select Settings.



7. Click on a title to view it. The **Read** button indicates you have access through the PPLD subscription. You can also set the auto-download option.
