Claire, Celine. <u>Shelter</u>. (Though many refused shelter to two strangers in a storm, will the strangers now show kindness, when someone needs it?)




Cho. <u>Rice from Heaven.</u> (Two South Korean children send bags of rice over the border of North Korea, to feed children who are starving).

Kerascoet. <u>I Walk With Vanessa: A Story About a Simple Act of Kindness</u>. (How can someone help stop the bullying of someone in her class...with a simple act of kindness.)



Madden, Colleen. What if Everybody Said That? (A self-centered child is asked to consider what the world would be like if everyone said terrible things).



Miller, Pat Zietlow. Be Kind. (At school, a child helps another by standing up for her and sharing.)
