Composing Your Masterpiece (Two Ideas)

When the background is ready, place your action figures on the paper, arranging them the way you want to glue them down. If you drew in a foreground line, try making part of each figure touch inside the foreground. That will make them look like the FOCUS of your project. Leave them in place and glue down one at a time, using one of the following ideas.

- 1. If you want the figures to really POP, glue a packing peanut to the back of each figure, then glue the packing peanut to the background. This gives your piece dimension.
- 2. Or ... just glue the figures directly to the background!

*Your figures can be placed anywhere on your paper. They can tell a story or just show lots of action. This works well if you made a background using bubble wrap or doodles!
